Why have Rick Roser as your school's artist-in-residence?

A residency with Rick Roser provides a true hands-on experience that will leave a lasting and positive impact on your school community, engaging your students in Aboriginal Culture.



Workshop content

Burri Burri! with Rick Roser has students exploring Aboriginal culture hands-on!

Summary of activities:

- Painting face, hair and arms using real ochres
- Emu feather headdresses using ochres, beeswax, emu feathers
- The Aboriginal Art of Fire Making using traditional fire sticks (takes approx 20 years of practice but everyone loves to try!)
- Boomerang and spear throwing using a Woomera (demonstration only)
- Didjeridoo workshop includes circular breathing
- Storytelling and cultural information with all workshops

Numbers

Maximum 100 students per workshop

Staging requirements

- Concrete undercover area is ideal for workshop
- Indoor classrooms or halls are not suitable
- Immediate access to oval is good
- Not recommended for special schools

Booking

Pricing does not include cost of travel and accommodation outside the Brisbane area. Dates and budgets must be negotiated and finalised by contacting the **Ontour inschools** team.

One-hour workshop (min 65 students, max 100 students), \$600+GST.

Full day residency (min 4 sessions, max 5 sessions), \$5 per student.
